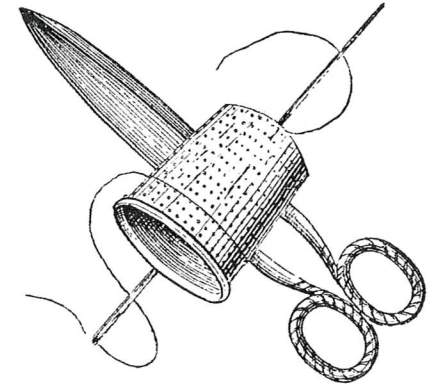




Repair What You Wear Series
